ORAL STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARIAT IN CONNECTION WITH DRAFT
RESOLUTION A/HRC/61/L.30 ENTITLED "Prevention of genocide".

1. This statement is made in accordance with rule 153 of the Rules of procedure of the General Assembly.

2. Under the terms of operative paragraphs 39, 42, and 44 of draft resolution **A/HRC/61/L.30**, the Human Rights Council would:

(a) Request the Secretary-General, in collaboration with the Office on Genocide Prevention and the Responsibility to Protect and with relevant entities of the United Nations system, Governments and other stakeholders, to help to ensure the success of the observance by the United Nations of the International Day of Commemoration and Dignity of the Victims of the Crime of Genocide and the Prevention of This Crime and to assist States, upon request and in compliance with the provisions of resolution 69/323 relating to funding, in organizing activities for the observance of the International Day (OP. 39);

(b) Request the Secretary-General to draw up a roster of focal points and networks on the prevention of genocide with updated information from States (OP. 42);

(c) Invite the Special Adviser on the Prevention of Genocide to an interactive dialogue with the Human Rights Council at its sixty-fifth session on the progress made in discharging his duties (OP. 44).

3. In order to implement the mandate contained in paragraphs 39, 42, and 44 of the draft resolution, the following activities and resources would be required in 2027:

4. **Under Section 24, Human Rights:**

(a) Travel of Representatives:

- One trip in 2027 by the Special Adviser to Geneva, to attend the one-day interactive dialogue at the sixty-fifth session of the Council (OP.44).

5. The activities referred to above relate to **Section 24, Human rights** of the programme budget for the year 2027.

6. The adoption of the draft resolution **A/HRC/61/L.30** would give rise to total requirements as follows:

7. As reflected in the table above, requirements would arise as follows:

- a. Additional non-recurrent requirements of \$6,500 for 2027. These requirements, in accordance with established procedures, would be brought to the attention of the General Assembly, at its 81st session under the agenda item on proposed programme budget for 2027.
